

Ordinance 2010-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (4901) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Police Chief Mark Lombardi informed the Village of Hiram Budget and Finance Committee on July 27, 2010 of his departments need for new radios; and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously transferred money into the Capital Improvement Fund (4901) in conformity with Resolution 2009-8 for capital purchases by the Village of Hiram Police Department.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has received a quote for the needed radios in the amount of \$3,539.90 and requests these radios be purchased out of the Capital Improvement Fund monies identified for the Police Department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the Capital Improvement Fund (4901) are \$142,000 as set forth in Ordinance 2010-4 attached as Exhibit "A." An increase of \$3,539.90 the new appropriations is hereby approved resulting in a new appropriated of amount of \$145,539.90.


Section 2: The current amount available to the Police Department for capital purchases is \$18,914.59. After the purchase of the radios requested in this piece of legislation the new balance will be \$15,374.69.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence so the residents of the village can benefit from working radios in all the police cruisers.






