

ORDINANCE 2009-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE STATE EMS FUND (2062) BY \$10,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Fire Department has received a grant for training and equipment from the Ohio Division of EMS for award year 2009-2010; and

WHEREAS, the grant is a reimbursing grant; and

WHEREAS, the State EMS Fund (2062) will need \$5,500 to spend on grant purchases and \$5,500 to pay back an advance from the General Fund (1000) in the amount of \$5,500.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds (2/3rds) or more of the members thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the State EMS Fund (2062) are \$1,000. With an additional \$10,000 added the new appropriations will become \$11,000.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because this would correct amount of appropriations to be in place because expenditures need to be made timely and the reimbursement requested.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




