

Ordinance 2010-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (4901) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of Hiram has determined that money from the Capital Improvement Fund should be used for the purchase of a new fire engine; and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously transferred money into the Capital Improvement Fund (4901) in conformity with an agreement for services with Hiram Township, which money has been designated to be used for such a purchase such as a new fire engine.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the Capital Improvement Fund (4901) are \$42,000. An increase of \$100,000 the new appropriations is hereby approved resulting in a new appropriated amount of \$142,000.


Section 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence so the residents of the village can benefit from a pre-payment discount on the purchase of the new fire engine.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formation action were in meetings open to the public in compliances with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.





