

ORDINANCE 2010-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM'S EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK, CHAPTER 4 INTRODUCTION AND CHAPTER 6 SECTION 6.4 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2006-19 was enacted by council April 10, 2007 establishing a new hand book for the employees of the Hiram Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council has decided to amend the introductory paragraph to Chapter 4 and Section 6.4 of Chapter 6 of the Employee Handbook.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section One: The current introductory paragraph to Section 4 and Section 6.4 of Chapter 6 of the Employee Handbook are hereby repealed.

Section Two: The attached Exhibit A, which sets forth a new introductory paragraph to Chapter 4 of the Employee Handbook is hereby enacted.


Section Three: The attached Exhibit B, which sets forth a new Section 6.4 of Chapter 6 of the Employee Handbook is hereby enacted.

Section Four: On both Exhibits the text which contains a ~~strikeout~~ and the *italics* are included to show the changes only, and the enacted text shall not include the ~~strikeout~~ text, and the *italics* shall be omitted.


Section Five: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, effective immediately upon its passage to allow for consideration of any potential pay increases.

Section Six: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
