

Ordinance 2010-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING FUND: SEWER FUND (5201) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has determined the appropriations in the Sewer Fund (5201) need to be increased; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Fund (5201) paid for a generator for SR 700 pump station; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Fund (5201) did not anticipate this expenditure.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Sewer Fund (5201) are \$469,847. With an increase of \$30,000 the new appropriations total will be \$499,847. The Other Operations currently are appropriated at \$372,847 and will become \$402,847. The Personal Services will remain at \$97,000.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence to get the appropriations so the wastewater department can do needed repairs.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formation action were in meetings open to the public in compliances with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


