

ORDINANCE 2010-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND FIVE DOLLARS (\$7,505) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Police Chief Mark Lombardi informed the Finance Committee that the Police Department appropriations will be short due to the Chief's extended medical absence following a non work related accident; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations accounts for part-time officers wages and benefits will be short money to finish the year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund (1000) are \$1,041,536.67. The Personal Services section of the Police Law Enforcement needs to be increased by \$6,500 from \$137,838.00 to \$144,338. The Other Operations section of the Police Law Enforcement needs to be increased by \$1,005 from \$115,286 to \$116,291. An increase of \$7,505 is hereby approved resulting in a total appropriated amount of \$1,049,041.67.

Section 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to provide for the health and safety of the residents of Hiram Village and for the further reason that it is essential to maintain uninterrupted police coverage within the Village.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

Passed in council as an emergency November 9, 2010.
