

ORDINANCE 2009-27

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FEMA ASSISTANCE TO FIRE FIGHTERS GRANT FUND (2905) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Hiram Fire Department has received a grant from the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance to Firefighters Grant Fire Prevention and Safety Program in the amount of \$11,400; and

WHEREAS, as a result the permanent appropriations in the FEMA Assistance to Firefighters fund (2905) will need to be increased by \$11,400.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The FEMA Assistance to Firefighters fund (2905) currently has appropriations of \$50,083 from a grant currently in place. This additional grant will be identified through a cost center code of 0118 to allow for tracking of the expenditures and receipts. The new total appropriations will be \$61,483.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence to get the appropriations in place for these newly received grant funds and the fire department will be able to make necessary expenditures.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




