

ORDINANCE 2009-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING FUNDS: GENERAL FUND (1000) FIRE DEPARTMENT (120) AND SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (2901) AMBULANCE/EMS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the contract between the Village and the Township for fire and EMS services was increased; and

WHEREAS, there will be an additional \$35,000 for 2008 services since the new contract is retroactive to 1/1/2008; and

WHEREAS, the agreement for 2009 provides an additional \$15,000 for EMS and \$20,000 for fire the permanent appropriations need increased.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The permanent appropriations in the Fire Department section (1000-120) of the General fund need to be increased by \$20,000. The Personal Services section needs increased by \$12,000 from \$44,400 to \$56,400. The Other Operations section needs to be increased by \$8,000 from \$98,241 to \$106,241. The total appropriations for the Fire Department section of the General Fund will be \$162,641.


SECTION 2: The total permanent appropriations in the General Fund will be increased by \$20,000 from \$970,403 to \$990,403.

SECTION 3: The permanent appropriations in the Ambulance/EMS fund (2901) will be increased by \$6,000 in the Personal Services section. The current appropriations are \$109,000 in the Personal Services section and will become \$115,000 with this increase. The total appropriations in the Ambulance/EMS fund currently are \$183,750 and will become \$189,750 with this increase.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence to get the appropriations so the Fire Department will be able to complete maintenance and staffing they desire for the health and safety of the citizens of the village.

SECTION 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




