

ORDINANCE 2009-23

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) OTHER FINANCING USES (900) BY \$5,500. ALSO AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,500 TO THE STATE EMS FUND (2062) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Fire Department received a training and equipment grant for award year 2009-2010 in the amount of \$5,500; and

WHEREAS, the grant is a reimbursing grant; and

WHEREAS, the EMS grant fund (2062) will need to have \$5,500 advanced from the General Fund and said advance will need to be repaid prior to the end of 2009.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds (2/3rds) or more of the members thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Other Financing Uses (900) section of the General Fund in Other Operations are \$94,600. With an increase of \$5,500 it will become \$100,100. The total current appropriations in the General Fund are \$1,076,590. With the additional \$5,500 the new total will become \$1,082,090.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because this would allow monies to be in the EMS grant fund and spent to request the reimbursing monies.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
