

ORDINANCE 2009-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND AND CREATING A DEPARTMENT IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR CAPITAL OUTLAY (800) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, at the June 14, 2009 council meeting Hiram Police Chief Mark Lombardi asked council for authorization to purchase a new police cruiser; and

WHEREAS, a motion to authorize Chief Lombardi to spend a maximum of \$21,000 for a vehicle and a maximum of \$6,200 to outfit the vehicle with the needed equipment was made by Mr. Wadkins and second by Mr. Spencer; and

WHEREAS, the result of the roll call vote was 4-0-1 and the motion passed.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: At this time in the appropriations for the General Fund there are no appropriations for Capital Outlay (1000-800). This is the area the purchase of the vehicle and the equipment need to be. So Capital Outlay (1000-800) needs to be appropriated with \$27,200. The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$1,049,390 and need to be increased by \$27,200 making the new appropriations in the General Fund \$1,076,590.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because this would allow for payment of the cost of a new vehicle and the cost of the equipment necessary to outfit the vehicle in a timely manner.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




