

Ordinance 2009-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE OTHER OPERATIONS SECTION OF THE FOLLOWING FUNDS: 2902 HIRAM COMMUNITY TRUST, 2903 FEMA GRANT, 2904 FARMLAND PRESERVATION, 2905 FEMA FIREFIGHTERS GRANT, 3901 WATERWORKS BOND, 5706 OWDA SR 82 WATER MAIN, 5721 OWDA SEWER DEBT, 9101 UNCLAIMED MONIES AND 9903 HRA REIMBURSEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Certificate of Estimated Resources was sent to the County with the year ending balances in all the funds; and

WHEREAS, after receiving the amendment from the County the following funds need the appropriations amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: All of the funds listed below need to have the appropriations in other operations increased to the amounts in the chart.
