

ORDINANCE 2009-30

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING FUNDS: WATER FUND (5101) AND WASTEWATER FUND (5201) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has determined the utility departments will be short in some of their appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the Water Fund (5101) started the year with a cash balance of \$105,786 and will have enough cash to pay the debt payments in December; and

WHEREAS, the Wastewater Fund (5201) started the year with a cash balance of \$163,373 and will have enough cash to pay the debt payments in December.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Water Fund (5101) are \$272,031. With an increase of \$10,650 the new appropriations total will be \$282,681. The Personal Services currently are appropriated at \$65,500 and will become \$70,500. The Other Operations currently are appropriated at \$206,531 and will become \$212,181.

SECTION 2: The current appropriations in the Wastewater Fund (5201) are \$395,892. With an increase of \$25,950 the new appropriation total will be \$421,842. The Personal Services currently are appropriated at \$87,600 and will become \$90,100. The Other Operations currently are appropriated at \$308,292 and will become \$331,742.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence to get the appropriations so the Utility department can continue to operate through year end.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




