

ORDINANCE 2010-19

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE PORTAGE COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER FOR DEFENSE OF INDIGENT PERSONS CHARGED WITH CRIMINAL OFFENSES UNDER THE VILLAGE ORDINANCES.


BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Hiram of Village, Portage County, Ohio two-thirds (2/3) or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are authorized on behalf of the Village to execute a contract with the Portage County Public Defender Commission for the representation of indigent persons charged under Hiram Village ordinances for and during the calendar year 2011 substantially in conformance with the terms and conditions as the contract for 2010, and for the compensation of eighty dollars (\$80.00) per offense charged. The approved Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".






