

ORDINANCE 2009-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) STREET DEPARTMENT FUND (620) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has advised the Village Council that the Street Department is in need of a new garden tractor at an approximate cost of \$15,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the funds needed for the purchase of the garden tractor were not included in the Street Department 2009 appropriations, which now necessitates an increase in the appropriations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The permanent appropriations as approved for the Street Department within the General Fund total \$105,600.00. An additional \$15,000.00 must be appropriated for the purchase of the new garden tractor. As a result the other operations section of the Street Department portion of the General Fund will increase to \$49,400.00 from \$34,400.00. The total appropriation in the Street Department within the General Fund in the amount of \$120,600.00 is authorized.

SECTION 2: The permanent appropriations for the General Fund will be increased by \$15,000.00 resulting in the appropriations changing from \$952,816.00 to \$967,816.00.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor in order to fund the purchase of the garden tractor in advance of the start of mowing season.


SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

Passed in council as an emergency March 10, 2009.




