

ORDINANCE 2009-11

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A KUBOTA B7100 TRACTOR WITH LOADER OWNED BY THE VILLAGE, NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 721.15 authorizes municipalities to sell personal property no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Robert Wood, the Village Administrator, has determined that the Kubota B7100 tractor with loader is no longer needed for any municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Kubota B7100 tractor with loader is using a portion of the limited amount of storage area which is available to the Village of Hiram.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The Council authorizes the advertisement, for sale, of the Kubota B7100 tractor with loader for not less than two (2) or more than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipal corporation and hereby ratifies all actions which have already been taken in conformity with this direction.

SECTION 2: The Council authorizes the sale of the Kubota B7100 tractor with loader to the highest bidder which is acceptable to the Village Administrator.


SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by Mayor, for the reason that the Kubota B7100 tractor with loader is presently occupying the limited storage space available to the Village of Hiram and also for the reason that it is anticipated that the sale of a tractor will bring a higher price in the spring of the year.




