

**JOINT RESOLUTION 2017-12 OF THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND  
THE HIRAM TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES.**

**A RESOLUTION AWARDED A CONTRACT TO PORTAGE COUNTY SOLID  
WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR RECYCLABLE COLLECTION SERVICE  
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND WITHIN HIRAM TOWNSHIP, PORTAGE  
COUNTY, OHIO.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Hiram has previously enacted legislation indicating that collection and disposal of public waste or garbage is a public utility, and recyclable solid waste is included in the provisions of the legislation, and for that reason, the recyclable solid waste generated within the Village shall be removed by a single service provider; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Hiram Township has previously passed a resolution authorizing participation in the competitive bidding process with Hiram Village; and

**WHEREAS**, a bidding process has been authorized and undertaken to request bids for recycling collection service within Hiram Village and within Hiram Township in conformity with law; and

**WHEREAS**, the advertisement for bids was published in the Record Courier, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Hiram and in Hiram Township on April 2, 2017 and on April 9, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, Portage County Solid Waste Management District was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the recycling collection service in Hiram Village and in Hiram Township; and

**WHEREAS**, at a special joint meeting of the Hiram Village Council and the Hiram Board of Township Trustees held on May 23, 2017 the Hiram Village Council and the Hiram Township Board of Trustees each separately passed a motion to award the recycling collection service contract in the Village of Hiram and in Hiram Township to Portage County Solid Waste Management District; and

**WHEREAS**, by the passage of this legislation the Hiram Village Council and the Hiram Township Board of Trustees desire to ratify the actions taken at the special joint meeting held on May 23, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Hiram desires to award the contract for recycling collection service within the Village of Hiram to Portage County Solid Waste Management District in conformity with the bid submitted for a period of seven years; and

**WHEREAS**, Board of Township Trustees desires to award the contract for recycling collection service within Hiram Township to Portage County Solid Waste Management District in conformity with the bid submitted for a period of seven years.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Hiram Village Council, and by the Hiram Township Board of Township Trustees, as their interests appear, two thirds or more of each of their members concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** The bid submitted by Portage County Solid Waste Management District is declared to be the lowest responsive and responsible bid for recycling collection service within the Village of Hiram.

**SECTION 2:** The bid submitted by Portage County Solid Waste Management District is declared to be the lowest bid for recycling collection service within Hiram Township.

**SECTION 3:** That a contract in substantial conformity with the terms contained in the bid attached hereto and marked for identification as Exhibit "A" between Portage County Solid Waste Management District and the Village of Hiram, is hereby authorized for a term of seven full years commencing on September 1, 2017. The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are directed to execute said contract.

**SECTION 4:** That a contract in substantial conformity with the terms contained in the bid attached hereto and marked for identification as Exhibit "A" between Portage County Solid Waste Management District and Hiram Township for a term of seven full years commencing on September 1, 2017, is hereby authorized.

**SECTION 5:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and the Board of Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
