

ORDINANCE 2025-01

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Village of Hiram Council authorized RES 2024-32, a contract with T2 Systems for the purpose of implementing a parking violations enforcement system;

WHEREAS, Village of Hiram Council authorized ORD 2024-26, the purchase of a 2024 Interceptor. The balance of the purchase of the vehicle was financed on a 4-year loan;

WHEREAS, equipment needed to complete a Water/Sewer project was not covered by grant funding, and there remains an open invoice from Core and Main in the amount of \$19,951.00;

WHEREAS, current appropriations are insufficient to pay the Fiscal Officer the 2025 salary. The balance of \$8,000.00 is being proportionally allocated;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM, OHIO, three fourths or more of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The following chart outlines the authorized amendments to the enumerated funds:

Section 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the department of the Village of Hiram to continue to function and pay their obligations to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formation action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

PASSED IN COUNCIL as an emergency on January 14, 2025.




