

ORDINANCE 2011-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (2906) FROM ZERO TO \$72,548.47 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has spoken to Lisa Reeves at Portage County Regional Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Reeves stated the last payment should take place before the end of June; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Reeves sent the Fiscal Officer a spreadsheet via email showing all the costs associated with this grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the Community Block Grant Fund (2906) are ZERO and need to be increased to \$72,548.47. This is the total cost of the project sent to the Fiscal Officer. The new total appropriations in the Community Block Grant Fund (2906) will be \$72,548.47.

Section 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to book the benefit of this project to the citizens of the Village of Hiram in a timely fashion.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliances with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
