

ORDINANCE 2023-13

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A GRANT AND AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE KIDS AND COPS FISHING DAY SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (2274-110-420-0127) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief for the Village of Hiram presented the Fiscal Officer with information that the Hiram Police Department made application for and was successful in their efforts to secure a \$500.00 NOPEC Grant to be used towards our, "Fishing with a Cop" program.; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has requested the permanent appropriations in Fund 2274 be amended to allow for the use of the \$500.00 grant monies received from the NOPEC Grant to assist in costs relating to, "Fishing with a Cop" Program; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has requested all of his available monies in Fund 2274, which includes a donation of \$230.50, be appropriated to use towards the costs relating to, "Fishing with a Cop" Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The grant is accepted.

SECTION 2: The current appropriations in the Kids and Cops Fishing Day is \$500.00. An increase of \$500.00 & \$230.50 in new appropriations is hereby approved resulting in a new appropriated amount of \$1,230.50.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the Fiscal Officer to increase the, "Kids and Cops Fishing Day", to cover the expense of costs associated with this program.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formation action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
