

ORDINANCE 2024-03

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PROPORTIONING OF VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND ASSISTANT VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR SALARIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram's Village Administrator and Assistant Village Administrator devote their work and time equally between the water, sewer and general responsibilities for the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council can more accurately state the way the Village Administrator and Assistant Village Administrator's work responsibilities are allocated and use the appropriate Village funds to proportionally pay their salaries; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, County of Portage, State of Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: Village Council hereby adopts and enacts the percentages set forth below effective with the first pay in March 2024 to be used in establishing the proper allocation for the Village Administrator and Assistant Village Administrator salaries between and among the following funds in the percentages set forth below:


- 1/3 of gross pay is to be allocated from the General Fund (#1000)
- 1/3 of gross pay is to be allocated from the Water Fund (#5101)
- 1/3 of gross pay is to be allocated from the Sewer Fund (#5201)

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public, peace, health and safety of this municipality and to provide for the financial health of the Village. Wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of its members elected or appointed to this Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
