

**ORDINANCE 2024-10**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN SEVERAL FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Administrator for the Village of Hiram determined there was a need to make necessary repairs to the failing storm sewer drain alongside the Rosser Municipal Building including the replacement of cement and pipe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Hiram was informed that their current insurance pool, the Ohio Municipal Joint Self-Insurance Pool has terminated operations and in order for them to protect their current and past members against open known and potential unknown claim liabilities, OMJSIP has purchased a unique reinsurance policy and must now assess each of their members based on their claims loss and have assessed the Village of Hiram \$34,760; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hiram Recreation and Parks Board of the Village of Hiram has arranged to hold a Community Movie Night on May 3<sup>rd</sup> and the Mayor generously donated the upfront costs to put on this event so appropriations will need to be amended to allow for the donation received to cover the upfront costs for the event; and

**WHEREAS**, to meet these obligations several funds will need to have their appropriations increased.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


**SECTION 1:** The following chart outlines the authorized amendments to the enumerated funds:

**SECTION 3:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
