

ORDINANCE 2007-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING FUNDS: FEMA GRANT (2903), OWDA S.R. 82 (5706), OWDA SEWER DEBT (5721) AND HRA REIMBURSEMENT (9903) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, these accounts all had carry-over funds from 2006 that would be able to be spent in 2007 and;

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the village to have these monies available to be spent if that need were to exist in these funds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: FEMA Grant fund 2903 should have \$14.73 appropriated. OWDA S.R. 82 fund 5706 should have \$790.20 appropriated. OWDA sewer debt fund 5721 should have \$2,120.08 appropriated. HRA reimbursement fund 9903 should have \$6,474.72 appropriated.


SECTION 2: That this Ordinance be declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because this would allow the village's appropriations to be accurately portrayed to the citizens of the village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




