

ORDINANCE 2007-3

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND CONFIRMING THE AUTHORITY OF THE FISCAL OFFICER TO MOVE MONEY BETWEEN LINE ITEMS WITHIN A FUND, INCLUDING BOTH APPROPRIATIONS AND REVENUES, AND RATIFYING PAST ACTIONS WHICH ARE NOW AUTHORIZED BY THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, in the regular course of Village business the Fiscal Officer is challenged with conforming all payment requests placed by the department heads to the previously approved limits of the respective departmental budgets; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish this task it becomes necessary for the Fiscal Officer to adjust amounts within the funds appropriations by line item while simultaneously maintaining the approved appropriations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least a majority of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: Without additional approval beyond that granted in this ordinance, the Fiscal Officer is authorized to move Village monies between line items within funds for the purpose of maintaining their appropriations while allowing all the line items to balance. This authority is only for movement within funds. Authority is also granted to the Fiscal Officer to make supplemental appropriations within the funds as long as the total appropriated amount for the fund conforms to that approved by the appropriation ordinance of current effect

SECTION 2: The authority granted in this Ordinance does not extend to the line item in the General Fund that has its origin in the monies moved from the Capital Improvement Fund (1000-920-920-0911) to the General Fund. Any money that is appropriated in this Line item cannot be moved unless the Fiscal Officer is authorized by the Council to do so.


SECTION 3: Actions taken by the Fiscal Officer prior to the passage of this Ordinance, but which would have been authorized by this Ordinance had it been enacted previously, and which are consistent with the authority given to the Fiscal Officer by council through passage of a certain motion at the June 8, 2004 meeting of Council, are hereby ratified.




