

ORDINANCE 2007-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING FUNDS: OWDA S.R. 82 (5706), HIRAM COMMUNITY TRUST (2902) AND UNCLAIMED MONIES (9101) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, these accounts need changes to the amount that has been appropriated and;

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the village to have correct amounts in each of these funds.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least three-quarters of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following amendments need to be made O.W.D.A. fund 5706 should have \$709.20 appropriated. Hiram Community Trust fund 2902 should have \$861.54 appropriated. Unclaimed Monies fund 9101 should have \$575.76 appropriated.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance be declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because this would allow the village's appropriations to be accurately portrayed to the citizens of the village of Hiram.


