

ORDINANCE 2007-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING FUND: STATE FIRE GRANTS (2061) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the fire department received an award of five hundred dollars (\$500); and

WHEREAS, the fire department wishes to use these funds along with the \$1217.15 that is already appropriated in this fund to help pay for five members of the department going to Maplewood Career Center for Fire Training I instruction.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Hiram of Village, Portage County, Ohio two-thirds (2/3) or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following amendment needs to be made to State Fire Grants (2061). An increase in the fund from \$1217.15 to \$1717.15, a reflection of the five hundred dollar grant award received by the department.


SECTION 2: That this Ordinance be declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because the fire department has sent these persons to training that has already begun and payment is expected.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

PASSED IN COUNCIL on June 12, 2007 as an emergency.
