

ORDINANCE 2007-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2007-19 TO ESTABLISH A PAY RANGE FOR THE POSITION OF FULL-TIME LABORER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram enacted Ordinance 2007-19 on July 23, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Council has now determined that it is appropriate to add an additional position of full-time laborer and to establish a salary range for that position.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: Ordinance 2007-19 is hereby amended to provide under Section 1(A) for a laborer, full time, with a range of pay from \$22,880 per year to \$29,120 per year.

SECTION 2: In all other respects, Ordinance 2007-19 is ratified.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be an emergency measure and effective immediately upon passage in order to allow the Village Administrator to hire a full-time laborer in order to meet the service requirements of the Village if Hiram.


