

ORDINANCE 2008-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS AND THE REVENUE BUDGET IN THE FOLLOWING FUNDS: FARMLAND PRESERVATION GRANT FUND (2904), FEMA ASSISTANCE TO FIRE FIGHTERS (2905) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Hiram was successful in obtaining a grant from the Center for Farmland Policy Innovation Farmland Protection Partnership Program in the amount of \$58,900; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Hiram was successful in obtaining a grant from the DHS Federal Emergency Agency's National Preparedness Directorate in the amount of \$73,654; and

WHEREAS, neither of these grants have money appropriated for 2008 and are incurring expenses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least three-quarters of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The Farmland Preservation Grant Fund (2904) should have the balance of the grant funds appropriated for 2008, \$40,351.35. This makes the amendment \$40,351.35; the current certified amount is zero.

SECTION 2: The FEMA Assistance to Fire Fighters Grant Fund (2905) should have the balance of the grant funds appropriated for 2008, \$62,824. This makes the amendment \$62,824; the current certified amount is zero.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because this would allow for payment of costs incurred with this project in a timely manner.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
