

**Ordinance 2008-09**

**An Ordinance accepting the bid of Apgar Ambulance to purchase the Village of Hiram 1996 Freightliner Horton rescue squad, authorizing the mayor and fiscal officer to enter into a contract with Apgar Ambulance, and declaring an emergency.**

**Whereas,** sealed bids were opened by the Village of Hiram on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008 for the sale of the Village's 1996 Freightliner Horton rescue squad; and

**Whereas,** A bid from Apgar Ambulance in the amount of \$25,000 was the only bid; and

**Whereas,** the bid from Apgar Ambulance, 5200 Howe Lane, Laramie Wyoming, 82070 was determined by the Village of Hiram to be the highest and best bid received; and

**Whereas,** in conformance with law said bid has been discussed with and considered by the Council of the Village of Hiram

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members thereto concurring:

**Section 1:** The actions of the Fire Chief of Hiram in bidding for the sale of the 1996 Freightliner Horton rescue squad in conformity with Ordinance 2008-2 are hereby ratified.

**Section 2:** Apgar Ambulance's bid for the purchase of the 1996 Freightliner Horton rescue squad is hereby determined to be the highest and best bid received.

**Section 3:** The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Apgar Ambulance, 5200 Howe Lane, Laramie Wyoming, 82070 for the sale of the 1996 Freightliner Horton rescue squad in the amount of \$25,000 in cash and without warranty; said contract to contain the terms set forth in this Ordinance and to substantially incorporate the terms and conditions proposed in the attached Exhibit "A".

**Section 4:** That this Ordinance be declared an emergency measure becoming immediately effective upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, the particular emergency being that time is of the essence regarding the sale of said vehicle since sale of said vehicle impacts the purchase of the new rescue squad.

**Section 5:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

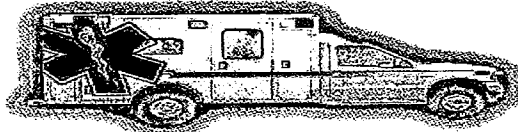
