

ORDINANCE 2008-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND TO COVER THE EXPENSES OF THE CONTRACT WITH POGGEMEYER DESIGN GROUP NOT-TO-EXCEED \$8,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the council of the Village of Hiram accepted the bid from Poggemeyer Design Group to compile an economic impact study of the probable effect of the proposed Hiram Senior Living development; and

WHEREAS, this cost of the economic impact study was not allocated in the 2008 permanent appropriations.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$870,123 and need to be increased by \$8,000 to \$878,123. The contract with Poggemeyer Design Group is not-to-exceed a maximum fee of \$8,000. In the section of the General Fund permanent appropriations under General Government Other Operations this section will increase from \$189,499 to \$197,499. The total for General Government will increase from \$290,000 to \$298,000.


SECTION 2: That this Ordinance be declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the village's appropriations to be accurately portrayed to the citizens of the village of Hiram and to make payment to Poggemeyer Design Group upon completion of the work and in conformity with the Village's contractual obligations.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

This piece of legislation passed as an emergency on May13, 2008.
