

ORDINANCE 2008-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (4901) TO COVER THE COST OF THE NEW AMBULANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, at the April 8, 2008 council meeting the purchase of a new ambulance was authorized; and

WHEREAS, the sale of ambulance 1711 was also authorized at the April 8, 2008 meeting.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Capital Improvement Fund (4901) are \$88,000. There needs to be an additional \$28,000 appropriated, making a total of \$116,000.


SECTION 2: That this Ordinance be declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because this will allow for the prompt payment of the new ambulance upon delivery.


SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

This piece of legislation passed as an emergency on May 13, 2008.
