

ORDINANCE 2008-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING FUNDS: STATE FIRE GRANT (2061) AND STATE EMS GRANT (2062) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Fire Department has been awarded \$2,300 from the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal, Ohio Fire Academy for a 2007 Training Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Fire Department has been awarded \$5,500 from the Ohio EMS Board for grant year 2008-2009.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The appropriations in the State Fire Grant Fund (2061) are currently \$2,000 and need to be increased by \$300 making the total appropriation \$2,300. The appropriations in the State EMS Grant Fund (2062) are currently \$2,000 and need to be increased by \$3,500 making the total appropriation \$5,500.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because this would allow the village's appropriations to be accurately portrayed to the citizens of the village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

This piece of legislation passed on July 8, 2008 as an emergency.
