

Ordinance 2008-18

An Ordinance accepting the bid of Communications Service for new portable radios to be used by Hiram Fire Department, authorizing the mayor and fiscal officer to enter into a contract with Communications Service, and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, sealed bids were received by the Village of Hiram on July 29th, for the purchase of 20 new portable radios in accordance with specifications on file with the Village; and

Whereas, the following bids were received: Communications Service \$22,852, and Independence Communications \$26,400; and

Whereas, in conformance with law said bids have been discussed with and considered by the Council of the Village of Hiram; and

Whereas, the bid from Communications Service, 250 Fairgrounds Road, Painesville Ohio, 44077 has been determined by the Village of Hiram to be the lowest and best bid received.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members thereto concurring:

Section 1: The actions of the Fire Chief of Hiram in bidding the purchase of new portable radios are hereby ratified.

Section 2: Communications Service's bid for new portable radios is hereby determined to be the lowest, best, and most responsive bid received.

Section 3: The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Communications Service, 250 Fairgrounds Road, Painesville Ohio, 44077 in the amount of \$22,852; said agreement to be substantially in conformance with the terms and conditions as hereto attached as Exhibit "A".


Section 4: These portable radios will be funded with \$19,391.90 from the 2007 Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program and \$3,460.10 from the Village of Hiram fire department line item.

Section 5: That this Ordinance be declared an emergency measure becoming immediately effective upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor the particular emergency being that time is of the essence to purchase the new radios because the grant period ends September 28th, 2008.




