

ORDINANCE 2008-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING FUNDS: STATE EMS GRANT (2062) AND STREET CONSTRUCTION (2011) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Hiram Fire Department is waiting to receive grant funds to be used for training for the Ohio Department of Public Safety in the amount of \$5,500 to be used for training; and

WHEREAS, the fund is currently appropriated at \$5,500 and has \$2,300 cash in the fund; and

WHEREAS, the increasing cost of fuel and road salt necessitate an increase in the Street Construction Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: At the present time the appropriations in State EMS Grant Fund (2062) are at \$5,500 and are hereby increased to \$7,500 to cover the cost of training for members of the Hiram Fire Department. Currently there is \$2,300 in cash in the Fund.

SECTION 2: At the present time the appropriations in the Street Construction Fund (2011) are at \$21, 000 and are hereby increased to \$26,000. Currently there is \$31, 359 in cash in the fund.


SECTION 3: That this Ordinance be declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor allowing the Fire Department to have personnel trained and the Street Department to purchase road salt and fuel assuring the health and safety of the village residents.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

This piece of legislation passed as an emergency on October 14, 2008.
