

ORDINANCE 2008-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING FUND: FARMLAND PRESERVATION GRANT (2904) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Farmland Preservation grant has been completed and closed; and

WHEREAS, the funds collected were less than anticipated the appropriations need to be adjusted to reflect actual numbers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: At the present time the appropriations in Farmland Preservation Grant are at \$40,351.35 and are hereby decreased by \$3,791.42 making the new appropriations \$36,559.93. This is a true reflection of what revenue was received into the fund.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor allowing the appropriations to be accurate for the end of the year.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

This piece of legislation passed as an emergency on December ¹¹ 8, 2008.
