

ORDINANCE 2008-28

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY,
SPECIFICALLY A 1941 FORD FIRE TRUCK, OWNED BY THE VILLAGE AND NO
LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 721.15 authorizes municipalities to sell personal property no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief, Gary Bott, has determined that the 1941 Ford fire truck owned by the municipality and formerly used by the Hiram Fire Department, is no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Chief Bott and the Council of the Village of Hiram have determined that there is no place within the Village of Hiram to store or park the 1941 fire truck; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has determined that it is necessary to offer for sale the 1941 Ford fire truck.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, State of Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Council authorizes the advertisement, for sale of the 1941 Ford fire truck for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipal corporation.

SECTION 2: The Council also authorizes the sale to the highest bidder in an internet auction.

SECTION 3: One thousand dollars (\$1,000) is established as the minimal acceptable bid for the 1941 Ford fire truck.


SECTION 4: The internet auction shall be performed in conformity with the procedures established in Resolution 2008-25 as enacted by the Village Council.

SECTION 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor for the reason that the 1941 Ford fire truck is presently housed outside and exposed to the elements, and the value of the truck will deteriorate the longer the vehicle remains outside.
