

ORDINANCE 2011-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$34,635 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer informed the Finance Committee of the unencumbered balance of \$5,089.63 in the annual appropriations of \$30,000 for the Solicitor's salary; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee recommended increasing the salary appropriation of the Solicitors salary from \$30,000 to \$60,000 also increasing the fringe benefits by \$4,200 in OPERS and \$435 in Medicare.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund after Ordinances 2011-06 & 2011-08 are \$913,240. The Personnel Services section in General Government will increase from \$110,238 to \$140,238. The Other Operations section in General Government will increase from \$189,893 to \$194,531. The new total for the General Government section will be \$334,736. The new total for the appropriations in the General Fund will be \$948,375.


Section 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to pay the Solicitor for services provided to the village and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


This piece of legislation was passed as an emergency on May 10, 2011.


