

ORDINANCE 2011-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CEMETERY FUND (2031) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has determined some unanticipated work needs to be done at the cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the work includes removing dead and dying trees, as well as the pruning of dead branches from other trees at the cemetery.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the Cemetery Fund are \$6,475. The Village Administrator is requesting an additional \$1,500 be appropriated. The new total appropriations in the Cemetery Fund with the additional \$1,500 will be \$7,975.


Section 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to ensure safety at the cemetery and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


This piece of legislation was passed as an emergency on August 9, 2011.
