

ORDINANCE 2011-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FIRST ENERGY GRANT FUND (2908) BY \$12,224 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram received a grant from First Energy to be used for state of the art lighting at the Municipal Building and the Service garage; and

WHEREAS, the amount of the grant and the village's matching portion needs to be appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the monies to repay the advance also need to be appropriated.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the First Energy Grant Fund are ZERO. They need to be increased to \$12,224. This will allow the advance repayment to the General Fund as well as the expenditures of the grant.


Section 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, effective immediately upon its passage, the particular emergency being the need to comply with all the requirements of the grant.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


This piece of legislation was passed as an emergency on August 09, 2011.



