

ORDINANCE 2011-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) IN THE STREET DEPARTMENT (620) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has determined that a new pickup truck to assist with the winter plowing is needed; and

WHEREAS, the Street Department appropriations have a surplus in the personal services area due to the Village Administrator becoming a part-time position; and

WHEREAS, by moving the money from personnel services to other operations the Village Administrator will have the money he needs to make the purchase by adding these monies to the capital improvement monies to purchase the needed pick-up truck.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the Street Department are \$108,540 with \$73,500 in Personal Services and \$35,040 in Other Operations. The new distribution needs to be \$59,500 in Personal Services and \$49,040 in Other Operations.


Section 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, effective immediately upon its passage, the particular emergency being the need to order the 2012 pickup truck and wait for delivery in time for the winter weather.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


This piece of legislation was passed as an emergency on September 13, 2011.


