

ORDINANCE 2011-31

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) IN THE COMMUNITY PLANNING AND ZONING (410) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the line item in the appropriations for payment of the Zoning Inspector's wages is \$30 short.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the Community Planning and Zoning are \$9,700 with \$3,000 in Personal Services and \$6,700 in Other Operations. The new distribution needs to be \$3,030 in Personal Services and \$6,670 in Other Operations.

Section 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to pay wages when they are due and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

This piece of legislation was passed as an emergency on October 11, 2011.
