

ORDINANCE 2016-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) POLICE DEPARTMENT (110) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, revenue has been received into the General Fund for the sale of Village properties and equipment once utilized by the Hiram Police Department that has been determined no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief desires to utilize these funds to help purchase a new 2016 Ford Explorer to replace the 2013 Police Cruiser destroyed in a crash.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: Current appropriations in the General Fund (1000) Police (110) are \$338,270.76. The increase in appropriations of \$13,100.00 from revenue received through the sale of Village properties will bring the Police appropriations to \$351,370.76. The current appropriations in line item 1000-110-550-0000 for Police Motor Vehicles are \$21,709.76. The new appropriations will bring this line item to \$34,809.76. The current appropriations in the General Fund (1000) are \$1,195,689.76. The new appropriations will be \$1,208,789.76.


Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and any of its committee that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council to advance the safety, general health and welfare of the Village and to allow for the Police Chief to maintain his fleet and enable his department to continue to perform their duties to ensure the safety and welfare of the citizens of Hiram Village and Hiram Township.


