

ORDINANCE 2016-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$8,759 AND APPROPRIATIONS IN THE SIDEWALKS FUND (4202) BY \$50,765 AND AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE OF \$8,759 TO THE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (4202) SIDEWALKS ON STATE ROUTES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram has requested and has been approved by the Ohio Department of Transportation for financial assistance in the form of a grant for the project entitled Sidewalks on State Routes; and

WHEREAS, the Sidewalks on State Routes grant is an 80/20 reimbursing grant so funds were transferred from the General Fund to the Sidewalks on State Route Fund (4202) in order to cover the 20 percent match for engineering costs incurred in 2015 and 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation provided the final contract documents for the project labeled POR-Hiram Village-PID 93825 to the Village of Hiram which were approved and signed by Council on April 12, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation has indicated a payment to the Treasurer of State in the amount of \$59,840.00 be forwarded for improving the described project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:


**Section 1:** The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$1,208,789.76. The appropriations need increased by \$8,759 in the advances out line item 1000-920-920-4014 to allow for the advance of funds. The new total appropriations in the General Fund will be \$1,217,548.76.

**Section 2:** The current appropriations in the Special Revenue Fund (4202) for Sidewalks are \$13,000.00. The appropriations need increased by \$50,765.00. The new total appropriations in the Sidewalks on State Routes Grant Project will be \$63,765.00.


**Section 2:** This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the Fiscal Officer to forward payment to the Ohio Department of Transportation by their deadline of May 20, 2016 to allow for the project to move forward as scheduled and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

**Section 3:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


