

ORDINANCE 2016-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CEMETERY FUND (2031) BY \$2,000

WHEREAS, appropriations in the cemetery maintenance funds have been depleted earlier this year by necessary expenses related to tree and stump removal as well as improvements to the roads in Fairview Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has determined that an additional \$2,000 is needed in the cemetery appropriations for continued maintenance through the remainder of 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has determined funds are available within the Cemetery Fund to cover the increased appropriations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the Cemetery Fund are \$6,345. The Village Administrator is requesting an additional \$2,000 be appropriated. The new total appropriations in the Cemetery Fund with the additional \$2,000 will be \$8,345.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


