

ORDINANCE 2016-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) POLICE DEPARTMENT (110) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, revenue has been received into the General Fund from an outside insurance company for damages to our Police Interceptor patrol vehicle while performing their routine duties; and

WHEREAS, permanent appropriations in the Police operating budget were used to make the repairs to the vehicle and pay the vendor in a timely manner once the work was completed; and

WHEREAS, the Police Sergeant presented to the Finance Committee his desire to appropriate the insurance money received in order to replenish their operating funds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: Current appropriations in the General Fund (1000) Police (110) are \$351,370.76. The increase in appropriations of \$982.09 from insurance monies received will bring the Police appropriations to \$352,352.85. The current appropriations in the General Fund (1000) are \$1,221,924.76. The new appropriations will be \$1,222,906.85.


Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council to advance the safety, general health and welfare of the Village and to allow for the Police Sergeant to maintain his fleet and enable his department to continue to perform their duties to ensure the safety and welfare of the citizens of Hiram Village and Hiram Township.


