

ORDINANCE 2016-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) POLICE LAW ENFORCEMENT (110) OTHER OPERATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has retired under a disability retirement effective July 5, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Police Sergeant has notified the Village of his plans to retire effective August 28, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations in the Police Department are not enough to cover the Police Chief's and Police Sergeant's retirement payout.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Personal Services section of the Police appropriations is \$196,808.00. The increase needed to the General Fund (1000) in order to cover the retirement payout is \$13,760. The current appropriations in the Other Operations is \$155,544.85. The increase needed to the General Fund (1000) is \$1,250. The current total appropriations in the Police Department are \$352,352.85. The increase of \$15,010 would bring the new appropriation total to \$367,362.85. This increase will bring the new total appropriations in the General Fund to \$1,237,916.85.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to ensure a smooth transition between retiring personnel and the hiring of new personnel in our Police Department and to allow the Village to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


