

ORDINANCE 2016-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND (4901) FOR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has advised the Finance Committee that Hayden Street is in desperate need of resurfacing due to the amount of vehicular traffic along our business district as well as traffic for Hiram College and the Post Office; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has advised Council of the need to make immediate and permanent repairs to the concrete pad in front of our Fire Department bays and along the parking area for our Police cruisers which is cracked and crumbling due to an inadequate depth of materials which can no longer support our fire equipment; and

WHEREAS, the funds needed for these capital improvement projects are not available within the 2016 permanent appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has requested to use funds in the Capital Improvement Funds, and in the Permissive Motor Vehicle License Tax Funds which now necessitates an increase in the appropriations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The permanent appropriations in the Capital Improvements Fund are \$47,808. An additional \$19,000 must be appropriated for a new concrete pad for Fire & Police. The total appropriation in the Capital Improvement Fund 4901-800-420-1700 in the amount of \$19,000.00 is authorized. An additional \$15,000 must be appropriated towards the resurfacing of Hayden Street. The total appropriation in the Capital Improvement Fund 4901-800-530-0054 in the amount of \$15,000.00 is authorized. The permanent appropriations in the Capital Improvement Fund will be increased by \$34,000.00 resulting in the appropriations changing from \$47,808 to \$81,808.00.

SECTION 2: The permanent appropriations in the Permissive Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund are \$2,200. An additional \$5,000 must be appropriated towards the resurfacing of Hayden Street. The total appropriations in the Permissive Fund 2101-620-420-0000 in the amount of \$5,000 are authorized. The permanent appropriations in the Permissive Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund will be increased by \$5,000 resulting in the appropriations changing from \$2,200 to \$7,200.00.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor in order to fund the infrastructure improvement projects during favorable weather and before the winter season.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
