

ORDINANCE 2016-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE SHOP WITH A COP FUND (2273) BY \$2,500.

WHEREAS, Acting Chief Brian Gregory has received donations for the Shop with a Cop program; and

WHEREAS, Acting Chief Gregory wants all the funds for the Shop with a Cop program to go into the Shop with a Cop Fund; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations in this fund will need to be increased to allow the Acting Chief to utilize a portion of the donations received.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio a majority of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Shop with a Cop Fund (2273) are \$2,000.

SECTION 2: An additional \$2,500 has been requested making the new total appropriations in this fund \$4,500.


