

ORDINANCE 2016-24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND (5701) FOR WATER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has advised the Finance Committee that some of the capital funds appropriated for water plant updates and infrastructure repairs in Ordinance 2016-17 were needed to help cover emergency repairs to Hiram Village water wells; and

WHEREAS, funds are still needed for repairs to well house #2; to replace sand in the filter bed, upgrade the control panel in the pump room and abate unusable cement pipe causing a liability in the amount of \$28,146.00 which are not available within the Water Department 2016 operating appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has requested to use funds in the Water Capital Improvement Fund which has been approved by Finance and now necessitates an increase in the appropriations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The permanent appropriations in the Water Capital Improvements Fund are \$37,479.00. An additional \$28,146.00 must be appropriated for the water plant upgrades and pipe abatement. The total additional appropriation in the Water Capital Improvement Fund 5701-800-590-0008 in the amount of \$28,146.00 is authorized.

SECTION 2: The permanent appropriations for the Water Capital Improvement Fund will be increased by \$28,146.00 resulting in the appropriations changing from \$37,479.00 to \$65,625.00.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor in order for the Village Administrator to expedite the required upgrades to the Village's water plant and to preserve the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
