

ORDINANCE 2018-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE DRUG LAW ENFORCEMENT FUND (2081) BY \$490.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Police Department was issued an evidence forfeiture from the Portage County Courts in the amount of \$1,960.00 of which 25% must be reimbursed back to the Courts; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has requested appropriations in that fund be amended to cover the 25% reimbursement payment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the DRUG LAW ENFORCEMENT Fund (2081) are ZERO. An increase of \$ 490.00 in new appropriations is hereby approved resulting in a new appropriated amount of \$ 490.00.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because the Village of Hiram is mandated to reimburse 25% of all cash forfeitures obtained through evidence seizures.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formation action were in meetings open to the public in compliances with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
