

ORDINANCE 2018-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000)  
PARKS (320) BY \$1,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has presented to the Finance Committee improvements his department is working on for the Jagow Park baseball field including new fencing around the field and at the backstop, new pavers, benches, bases, additional fill dirt and painting of existing structures; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator requested amending appropriations in the park operating line items within the General Fund by \$1,000 to accomplish these improvements prior to the use of the baseball fields by the residents for the summer season; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has given approval by a motion at their April 24<sup>th</sup> meeting to amend appropriations in the park operating funds by \$1,000; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations in this fund will need to be increased to accommodate these improvements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio a majority of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$1,130,151.42 with \$3,395.00 appropriated in Park Operating.

SECTION 2: The appropriations need increased by \$1,000 bringing the total appropriations in the Park Operating to \$4,395.00 and the total appropriations in the General Fund to \$1,131,151.42.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence to keep the project moving forward so the residents of the Village can benefit from the improvements being made.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


